Wes Bloomberg from the Noise Clearing House in Montpelier is our guest speaker... Wes has spent 25 years helping communities with sound ordinances... His team has complied a data base of the 500 largest cities in the USA each town having a minimum of 60,000 people. There are no towns in VT in that data. He has however worked with these towns in Vt.: Montpelier, St Albans and Fayston.

why have a sound ordinance: Will have a sound ordinance ... either have it proactive or after there is a problem. Define what is permitted and what is not. Developers need it...

Consider similar to controlling the landscape have a soundscape. Wes likes Distance (maybe 200 feet) that works because Pomfret is rural. Also Plainly audible, and the nuisance standard. Act 250 uses 70 decibels at the property line and 55 at the house. It wasn't clear why the ordinance and the bylaw did not accomplish the same thing... In a town without a police force hard to enforce the decibel. Inversions can cause the sound waves to bend. There is a state law re sound at night. Sound standard was mentioned for conditional use as we allow light industrial in town.
